## **REQUEST FOR MEETING OF THE GES-GNAT JOINT NEGOTIATING TEAM**

Following the request from your side at the sixth meeting of the Joint Negotiating Team to consult your principals we have still not received any invitation from you to resume the sittings.

Notwithstanding the reading of the 2007 National Budget, we wish to bring to your notice that we have still not concluded the assignment of negotiating salaries for year 2007 as well as proposals submitted for general Conditions of Service for teaching staff in the GES.

It is critical that the process of negotiations be sustained and completed by November 30, 2006. As a first step, the employee side is requesting that we should resume sittings beginning Monday, November 20, 2006 to conclude the issue of salaries.
